The Shawano Folk Music Festival brings the best of traditional and contemporary folk music and dance to Shawano during the 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend in August. 2005 marked the Festival's 27<sup>th</sup> year.

This annual family event, held at Shawano's Mielke Arts Center and Park, offers evening concerts on Friday and Saturday nights, daytime workshops on four outdoor stages on Saturday and Sunday, an Open Stage, a Sunday afternoon Festival Dance, crafters, food vendors, and the Quilt Raffle.
