Crafter Information Sheet August 13-15, 2010

Be a part of the 32nd annual Shawano Folk Music Festival

For 2010, there is no space rental fee for crafters!

On Saturday and Sunday between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm, artists and crafters line the walking paths of Shawano's Mielke Park, while some of the nation's finest traditional and contemporary folk musicians perform on four outdoor stages. Handmade original pottery, jewelry, clothing, carvings, musical instruments, garden items, painting, soaps, furniture, candles and many other handmade items are an important part of the festival tradition. (*Handmade items only. No resellers, please.*)

To get to Mielke Theater and Park in Shawano WI from Highway 29, take the Business 29 exit. Drive north to the stop light on Green Bay Road. Continue north (on Airport Road) for about one mile. Mielke Park will be on your left.

TIMES: Aug 13-15, 2010. Grounds open at 7:30 am for set-up. Festival gates open to the public from 10:00 am until 4:30 pm on Sat. and Sun.

SITES: Booth sites are awarded on a first-come-first-served basis, except for sites reserved for Festival use. Watch for sites that have been reserved by the Festival or other crafters when you choose a site. If you need help choosing a site, ask a Festival volunteer.

ADMISSIONS: Crafters and a limited number of helpers are admitted free to the Festival grounds. Stop at the Festival Office for admission badges. If you have questions, please call Joyous.

LODGING: The Shawano Chamber of Commerce (800-235-8528) can assist you in finding lodging.

PARKING: We have limited off-street parking, and reserve it for festival attendees. You may unload your vehicle in the parking lot, but please move it to Homewood Avenue or another street by 9:30 am.

SALES TAX: You are responsible for sending sales taxes in to the Wisconsin Department of Revenue. Shawano County charges 0.5% sales tax in addition to the Wisconsin 5% sales tax, for a total sales tax of 5.5%. Enclosed are the Revenue forms which the Festival must turn in to the State of Wisconsin. Please fill them in and bring them to the Festival.

RAFFLE: The Festival holds a raffle to help defray costs, with the drawing held on Sunday afternoon. Please consider donating a craft item to this effort. Your generosity will be greatly appreciated.

MISC: Note: Crafters' admission to the grounds does **not** include admission to concerts or to the "Green Room."
